INTRODUCTION AND HISTORY

The Bassetlaw Community Car Scheme has been in operation for over 12 years. It is open to all residents in Bassetlaw who are unable to access public transport. The scheme functions through The Retford Action Centre. The Manager of the Retford Action Centre is Lynn Tupling, the Project Officer for the scheme is Karen Greenwood and the car scheme bookings are taken by Keith Burlington and Laura Jarman.

The Bassetlaw Community Car Scheme is only available to local people who are unable to access any other forms of public transport.

The Scheme can be used to visit friends/social clubs, attend doctors/hospital appointments or maybe go shopping. It is a door to door service and the waiting time for volunteer drivers is 1hour maximum.

The current charges are 42p per mile that the driver travels, or 21p for clients that have a concessionary bus pass, which must be presented to the driver on every journey.

There is also a booking fee of 50p per journey.

All clients must register annually to use the scheme (currently free of charge).

We generally require 2-3 working days notice to book a journey, and clients are asked to provide 24hours notice if they wish to cancel a car, failure to do so may incur a late cancellation charge in addition to the driver's expenses.
